- 1. What do you think Mimi expected of her new life? How were her expectations met and not met during the course of this story?
- 2. Compare Mimi's move to one you have made. How was Mimi's experience the same and different from yours?
- 3. What were your first impressions of Mama, Papa, Timothy, Stacey, and Mr. Dell? How did your impressions change over the course of the story?
- 4. Which character did you most identify with?
- 5. If you were living in 1969, how has your life and the world around you changed since then? What do you consider to be the most significant changes, good and bad?
- 6. If you were not living in 1969, what changes have you observed since you were young? What do you consider to be the most significant changes, good and bad?
- 7. Mimi was a girl of mixed race living in a small town in 1969. Why do you think the story was set there and then?
- 8. If the story took place today, would her experience be different or the same? Why?
- 9. What universal issues and themes are presented in this story?
- 10. Talk about a time when you felt left out, different, or not acknowledged or understood. What were the circumstances? How did you feel? What was the outcome?
- 11. How have the roles of women changed since you were young? Of men? What are the pros and cons of each?
- 12. Do you think Mimi and her friends did the right thing when they protested at school? Why or why not? What do you think happened after that?
- 13. Talk about a time when you stood up for something you firmly believed in. What incited you to speak up or take action? What was the outcome?
- 14. Talk about a time when you faced something that scared you, the obstacles in your way, and the outcome.
- 15. Considering the historical events and social changes that occurred during that time, what do you think happened to Mimi after the story ended? To the rest of the characters?
